

## Theodor Liley Clemens Collection

Theodor Liley Clemens (1858-1933), English Moravian pastor, missionary, and musician.

Clemens, the son of a Moravian minister, was born in Yorkshire, England. After receiving his education and musical training he taught at Ockbrook (England), where he was ordained a Deacon. In 1886 he entered foreign missions work, serving as pastor in Antigua (West Indies) from 1886-1888, and in Moriah, Tobago from 1888-1917. In 1917 he came briefly to America, and resided in England from 1922 until his death.

Clemens composed many hymns, anthems, piano and organ pieces, and songs. Much of his sacred music was written for use in his own West Indies churches, where he trained his own choirs. Much of his music was also published in England.

Most of the collection is in manuscript form; the vast majority of the material is collected into bound volumes or manuscript books. Published music is found primarily in *Original Compositions* and the *Portfolio*.

### Brief Descriptions of Volumes and Manuscript Books

*Diversa for Piano Solo and Otherwise.* 40 ms. Pieces, composed 1877-1932.

Mostly secular piano works; also hymns and pieces for violin and piano and cello and piano.

*Manuscript Book.* 1870s to 1920s.

60 secular pieces (piano works; also vocal rounds and 2 pieces for violin and piano); close to 300 hymns.

*Original Compositions for the Organ.* 44 ms pieces, 1885-1922.

Non-liturgical preludes and voluntaries; some hymn preludes.

"Festival March" in C Major for Organ. Ms. Copy, same as No. 31 in organ volume.

*Original Compositions.* 18 printed pieces, 1879-1885.

Vocal music (solo songs; sacred choral music) and piano pieces.

*Musical Portfolio* and misc. loose compositions. Late 1880s to 1931.

27 works, almost all published. Piano compositions and studies, songs, anthems, carols, hymns, litany.

Correspondence file includes letters from Edward Bairstow, T. Tertius Noble, John Stainer, and Walford Davies.
